Bishop's Gardens' Last Summer Open Day Supports Local Charity

On Sunday 24th July, the Bishop of Norwich's Garden will be hosting The Matthew Project's family fun event on their last open day of the summer.

The family fun will include giant garden games, a quiz to help you explore the beautiful gardens and a raffle with prizes donated from a host of Norwich shops. Tea, coffee, cakes and soft drinks will be available for purchase on the day.

All proceeds will go to The Matthew Project, a charity that empowers people to live a full life free from alcohol and drug misuse as well as supporting individuals affected by the substance misuse of others.

The Matthew Project offers support for all ages at any stage of the recovery process with service users saying "My life wouldn't be where it is now if it wasn't for my worker".
